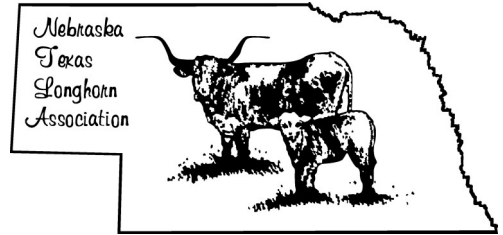

CONSIGNOR INFORMATION

SALE COMMISSION: For Catalog and Non-Catalog Cattle: 7% plus \$1/hd for Beef Check Off, hay is the responsibility of the seller and if purchased from the sale barn it will be deducted from your final check & mailed to you.

FUTURITY HEIFERS: There are 3 heifer categories: Jan—Dec 2017, Jan—Apr 2018, May—Dec 2018. Each lot entered in the futurity will be \$100 and judged with 50% payback according to entries received. The futurity heifers will be the first heifers to sell in the sale.

THE SALE COMMITTEE: Reserves the right to reject any animal at which time the consignor would be notified and consignment fee would be refunded.

Brand Inspection: Not required as Beatrice is not in the brand area.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS/Dr Max Hacker/(402)432-8891:

All Animals: One health paper per animal dated within 30 days of sale. ALL animals need a USDA official ID Tag & the # noted on the health papers. The following are considered official-USDA Silver Metal Tag, USDA Orange OCV Tag, or Visual & RFID 840-tag. Without this tag it cannot go out of state.

Females: All females need to have a calf at side, bred 90 days or more, or UNEXPOSED and so stated on the health papers to ensure it can be sold out of state . Preg status is required on all health papers.

Bulls: All bulls 12 months and older must be tested for trichomoniasis within 30 days of sale, semen test is recommended. Virgin bulls must be stated “Virgin Bull” on the health paper certified by your vet.

NONCATALOG CATTLE: Same requirement as for catalog cattle.

PLEASE NOTE: Check with your Vet & Nebraska State Vet for requirements importing into Nebraska & exporting to all states to ensure widest selling.

Other Comments: When unloading cattle it is the seller’s responsibility to pair up their cattle correctly.
